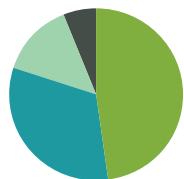

2022 Annual Report

Thanks to your generosity and support, in addition to an unprecedented 30% increase in our enrollment, your contributions allowed us to hire two additional teachers this year, bringing us to 11 Pathways teachers! We were able to add a new sport to our weekly schedule, with swimming lessons three times a week, and added a new weekly volunteering opportunity with Meals on Wheels! We hosted our very first Pathways prom, and added a new drama class twice per week, experimenting with movement, voice, character, rhythm, and timing to help build students' confidence and communication! And because of you, we were able to provide 85% more scholarships to families in need than ever before. We're blown away by all of you who have volunteered so much of your time and expertise and have given so generously of your resources to help these students live happier, healthier, and more enriching lives in 2022. What a blessing you have been to these families and this community!



DALTON'S STORY

Dalton laughed out loud. He'd just found yet another match in the memory game he and his mentor were playing. A young man full of joy and purpose sat in that seat, but it wasn't always that way. Since starting at Pathways in January 2022, Dalton's caretaker, his uncle Dave, says he has seen tremendous growth in his life, his confidence, and his joy.

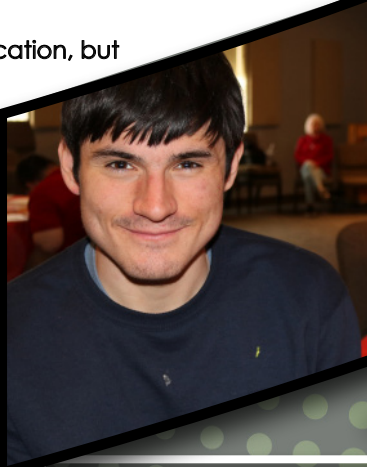
"I have seen him increase in his social interactions and math and reading skills." His uncle said. "One example would be being able to read instructions on video games without having someone else read them, which is a big deal. And as a baseball fan, he can now understand the stats."

Dalton said "What I'm most thankful for are my teachers and friends here."

In addition to growing in his math, reading, and life skills, Dalton is a trusted tour guide and helps with various facility maintenance tasks.

Because of the generosity of our supporters, he has been able to receive a 100% scholarship, which has made a huge impact on his and his uncle's lives.

"With bills stacking up, I wanted to provide Dalton with education, but that meant we would have to sacrifice things each month for him to attend the program full time. The scholarship, to me, means less sacrifice than it would be. It affords a better quality of life."

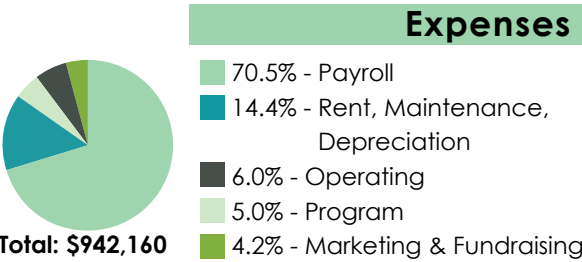
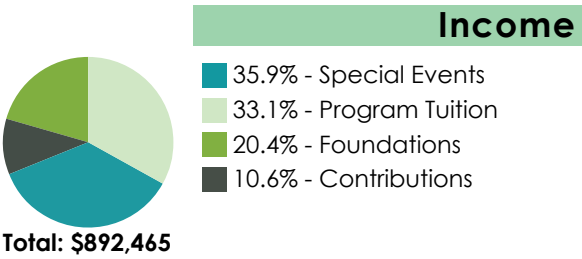
