Position Summary: The Full-Time Teacher is responsible for collaborating with and supporting other teachers in the classroom. This includes implementing the curriculum, ensuring the students are learning and growing, and keeping the students safe. Other duties as assigned. This position is full-time (40 hours per week).

Major Job Responsibilities:

Classroom Management

- Create a safe, warm, orderly and attractive learning environment for all students · Ensure that behaviors that are negatively affecting the Pathways classroom are addressed in a way that is in line with Pathways philosophies
- Safety
- Ensure the safety of all students that are in the care of Pathways · Ensure policies and procedures for Pathways Adult Learning Center are implemented and met
- Be aware of all medical conditions and allergies of students enrolled at Pathways providing teachers with that information as well
- Lead students through safety drills

Teaching

- Lead a variety of different activities including but not limited to: educational, bible study, worship, physical fitness and leisure activities
- Utilize a variety of effective teaching techniques
- Ensure that the goals set for each student are a focus and progress is assessed · Interact and guide the students within the classroom and during all outdoor activities

Community

- Lead students in volunteer activities in the community
- Assist in all Special Olympic activities
- Go on field trips with students that include a variety of different locations and experiences
- Transport students in shuttles or rental vehicles

You are going to love getting to know our Pathways students. Typically, we serve adults, ages 18 and older, who have intellectual disabilities. The most common disabilities among our students are Down Syndrome and Autism. Our students **do not** require assistance in the restroom, with eating, or with moving from room to room. Our students have a wide variety of strengths and talents - some students may be working on their alphabet and some read classic novels in their spare time. Our students are adults so we work hard to make our days filled with learning and experiences that are exciting, engaging and fun - from science experiments to book clubs to dance fitness parties.
