Key Responsibilities:**1. Facilitate Lessons:**

The role also involves assisting students with physical activities, including outdoor play, classroom transitions, and adaptive learning exercises. Additionally, this role involves navigating in the community during off-site activities and field trips, which may involve walking moderate distances.

Working Conditions:

- Part-Time position with standard program hours of 25 hours/week; occasional evenings or weekends for community activities.
- Classroom environment with involvement in various community settings.
